



Please Help Damon on his ALS Journey

My name is Damon Schlehuber I am 45 years old, a lifelong resident of Standish and a 1998 graduate of Bonny Eagle High School. On May 1, 2024, my life took a turn that I would never expect to happen to me or anyone else. I found out I have ALS. When they told me I had this diagnosis I was not familiar with what ALS entails. I quickly learned what it entails when the doctor said you need to get your life and finances in order and your life expectancy is 2-5 years. That was the most terrifying news I have ever heard. Since hearing this I have progressively gotten worse, it started with my right leg then went up to my right arm in just a few months I have gone from being a successful plumber to barely being



able to brush my teeth. Our family has had to learn new ways to live. We have had to learn to live with a diagnosis that every day has taken part of us away. I lost the ability to drive, tie my shoes, dress myself, bathe myself, and require full-time care. It feels that some days just getting out of bed and facing the day is hard because you feel as though you have no self-worth or you're a burden to others.

Life does not seem fair and my quality of life is hard without the items I need for my care. My wife resigned from her job to be a full-time caregiver for me. Paying household bills has become a hardship and adding the overwhelming financial burden this disease causes is impossible without help. Since my diagnosis I have sold many of the items I have worked my whole life for to have to pay for a ramp, care, a lift chair, and several items I may need to live life in my home as normal as possible, whatever that may mean.

It is embarrassing to ask for help but my wife, who is a therapist, stated we can't navigate this disease alone. She won't be able to do everything without a caregiver and I won't be able to live any sort of quality of life without the items I need to live for now. Any donation that you are willing to give helps with my care. I truly appreciate all your help. Thank you!



At the November 12, 2024, regular meeting of the Standish Town Council public hearings were held on the following amendments to the Standish Town Code, the ordinances adopted, becoming effective 30-days after this publication:

108-24 Amendments to Standish Town Code, Chapter 181, Land Use, Section 181-7.1., Form Based Code Village Districts (FBCVD), Regarding Building Mounted Signs Above the First Floor [Watson]

These amendments will allow wall-mounted signs above the first floor in the Standish Corner District.

109-24 Amendments to Standish Town Code Regarding the Division of Dispatch in the Following Chapters: Chapter 3, Administration of Government, Article X, Public Safety Department §3-36 Establishment, Department Head, Enumeration of Divisions and §3-44 Establishment Division of Dispatch; Chapter 142, Fire Prevention Article I, Sprinkler Systems, §142, §142-4 Installation; Chapter 181, Land Use, Article IV, General Standards, § 181-16.1 Blasting; and Chapter 252, Streets and Sidewalks, Article III, Construction and Acceptance, §252-23 (D), Naming and Naming and Numbering of Streets and Roads [Watson]

These amendments will remove references to the Town's Division of Dispatch as the town now contracts all local dispatch responsibilities to Cumberland County.

110-24 Amendments to Standish Town Code Regarding Private Roads in the Following Chapters: Chapter 181, Land Use, Article II, Definitions, §181.3 Terms Defined, §181-14 Lots; and Chapter 252, Streets and Sidewalks, Article V, Design Standards and New Construction, §252.31 Street Classification and Design Standards [Watson]

These amendments revise how private roads are handled under the ordinance including: allowing up to 5 dwellings on a gravel road, allowing new dwellings on pre-1996 private roads without bringing said roads up to current public road standards, and establishing maintenance standards for private roads that have winter maintenance agreements with the town.


James W. Bingham
