





**Question 1.** Shall the Town approve the charter amendments summarized below?

<u>Summary of Amendments</u>: The proposed charter amendments will add language to two existing sections of the Town Charter to allow an individual who resides on a parcel of land that is located in more than one of the four areas of Standish listed in Section 201 of the Town Charter to be considered a resident of each area and to seek election to the Town Council or Planning Board as a representative to any of the areas in which the individual resides, but once that selection is made, the individual is committed to that area for as long as he/she resides at that property. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to address an ambiguity that exists under the current language, which does not address this situation. The complete text of the proposed amendments is on file at the office of the Town Clerk.

When money is borrowed by issuing bonds, the Town must repay not only the principal amount of the bonds but also interest on the bonds. The amount of interest to be paid will vary depending upon the rate of interest and the years to maturity at the time of issue. The validity of the bonds and of the voters' ratification of the bonds may not be affected by any errors on the estimates made of the costs involved, including varying interest rates, the estimated cost of interest on the bond amount to be issued and the total cost of principal and interest to be paid at maturity. If the actual amount of the total debt service for the bond issues varies from the estimate, the ratification by the electors is nevertheless conclusive and the validity of the bond issue is not affected by reason of the variance.
