



Alice was a great cook. She loved making homemade chicken soup and donuts, fudge and peanut balls.



<u>Summary of Amendments</u>: The proposed charter amendments will add language to two existing sections of the Town Charter to allow an individual who resides on a parcel of land that is located in more than one of the four areas of Standish listed in Section 201 of the Town Charter to be considered a resident of each area and to seek election to the Town Council or Planning Board as a representative to any of the areas in which the individual resides, but once that selection is made, the individual is committed to that area for as long as he/she resides at that property. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to address an ambiguity that exists under the current language, which does not address this situation. When money is borrowed by issuing bonds, the Town must repay not only the principal amount of the bonds but also interest on the bonds. The amount of interest to be paid will vary depending upon the rate of interest and the years to maturity at the time of issue. The validity of the bonds and of the voters' ratification of the bonds may not be affected by any errors on the estimates made of the costs involved, including varying interest rates, the estimated cost of interest on the bond amount to be issued and the total cost of principal and interest to be paid at maturity. If the actual amount of the total debt service for the bond issues varies from the estimate, the ratification by the electors is nevertheless conclusive and the validity of the bond issue is not affected by reason of the variance.

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds and/or bond anticipation notes to include the principal amount of up to \$1,000,000 for the purpose of financing the construction of repairs and improvements to the culvert that crosses Strout Brook at Middle Road and the surrounding roadway, with the dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s) and other details of such borrowing to be determined by the Town Council, and to see if the Town will vote to appropriate the proceeds of said bonds or bond anticipation notes for the foregoing project, plus an amount necessary to refund the interest payments on any bond anticipation notes issued for said purpose, and any costs of issuance of the bonds and/or bond anticipation notes.

(Fiscal Note: This capital expenditure will be financed from a portion of the proceeds of general obligation bonds to be issued in a total principal amount of up to \$1,000,000. Total estimated debt service is \$1,210,527.42, of which principal is \$1,000,000 and estimated interest at an average rate of 3.6%, over 10 years is \$210,527.42.)
