State law prohibits parking any vehicle within a plowed right-of-way during snow plowing season.

Vehicles in violation WILL BE TOWED at the OWNER'S expense.

Mailboxes or other structures within a public right-of-way are there at the owner's risk. Neither the Town nor the Snow Plowing Contractor are responsible for damage by plows or sand trucks to said structures.

DO NOT PLOW, PLACE OR SNOW BLOW YOUR SNOW OUT ONTO THE ROAD (THIS INCLUDES SIDEWALKS)

Title 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2396 prohibits any person from placing in the public way snow or slush that has not accumulated there naturally.

If your plowing and snow extends into the road past what the Town has plowed, snow must be pushed back at least as far back as the Town plows.



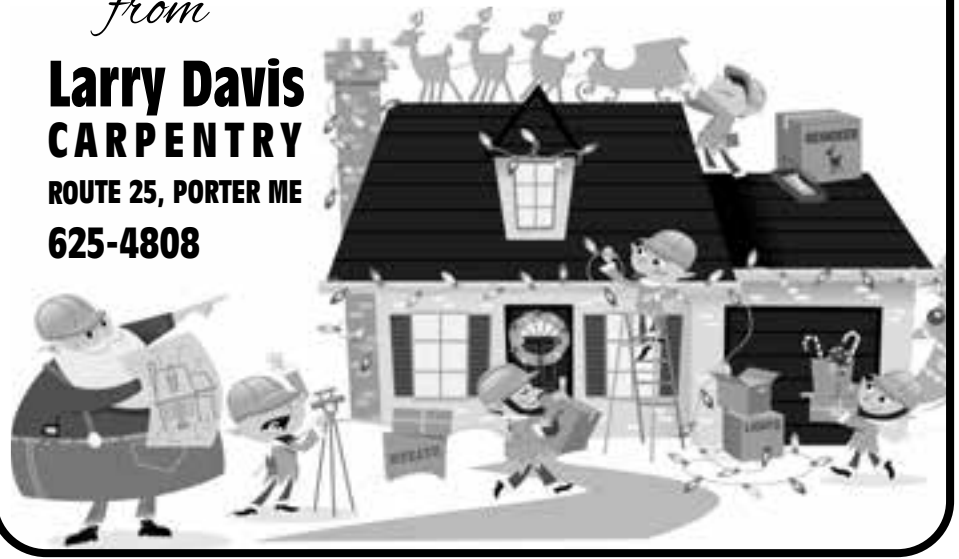

- 3 coffee beans to decorate

HOW TO MIX

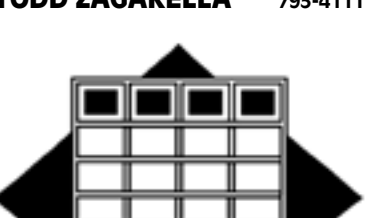
